**Tuition Policy** Indianapolis School of Ballet offers three payment options:

1. \* Payment in full for the entire year by August 14 will receive a 10% discount (cash or check only)
2. Payment by semester due August 15 and December 15 will receive a 5% discount
3. Nine installment payments due the 15th of each month August through April.

Convenient automatic deductions from a checking account, credit card or debit card are available.

**All tuition is due on the dates indicated above and will be considered overdue after ten (10) days. A late fee of \$20.00 will be billed. Students with delinquent accounts will not be permitted to take class. \*A \$20 bank fee will be charged for all returned checks.**

**Family Rates** are available to families with more than one child attending classes. The student in the highest level pays full tuition; each additional child enrolled receives a 10% discount.

**Refund Policy** Tuition is non-refundable except in the case of serious illness or injury as verified by a doctor's certificate.

**Withdrawal Policy** Students on the installment plan who voluntarily withdraw before the conclusion of the semester are responsible for paying the remainder of their semester tuition at the time of withdrawal. Students who wish to withdraw during or at the end of the semester must provide notice in writing prior to December 15 to avoid being charged second semester tuition.

**Scholarships** A limited number of financial aid scholarships are available to pre-professional students demonstrating financial need. Scholarships are awarded to students based on financial need, artistic ability and promise, and availability. Determinations are made on a case-by-case basis.
