Tuition Policy: Indianapolis School of Ballet offers three payment options:

All tuition is due on the dates indicated above and will be considered over due after ten (10) days. A late fee of \$20.00 will be billed. Students with delinquent accounts will not be permitted to take class. *A \$20 bank fee will be charged for all return checks.

Family Rates are available to families with more than one child attending classes. The student in the highest level pays full tuition; each additional child enrolled receives a 10% discount.

Refund Policy Tuition is non-refundable except in the case of serious illness or injury as verified by a doctor's certificate.

Withdrawal Policy Students on the installment plan who voluntarily withdraw before the conclusion of the semester are responsible for paying the remainder of the semester's tuition at the time of withdrawal. Students who wish to withdraw during or at the end of the first semester must provide notice in writing prior to December 15 to avoid being charged second semester tuition.
